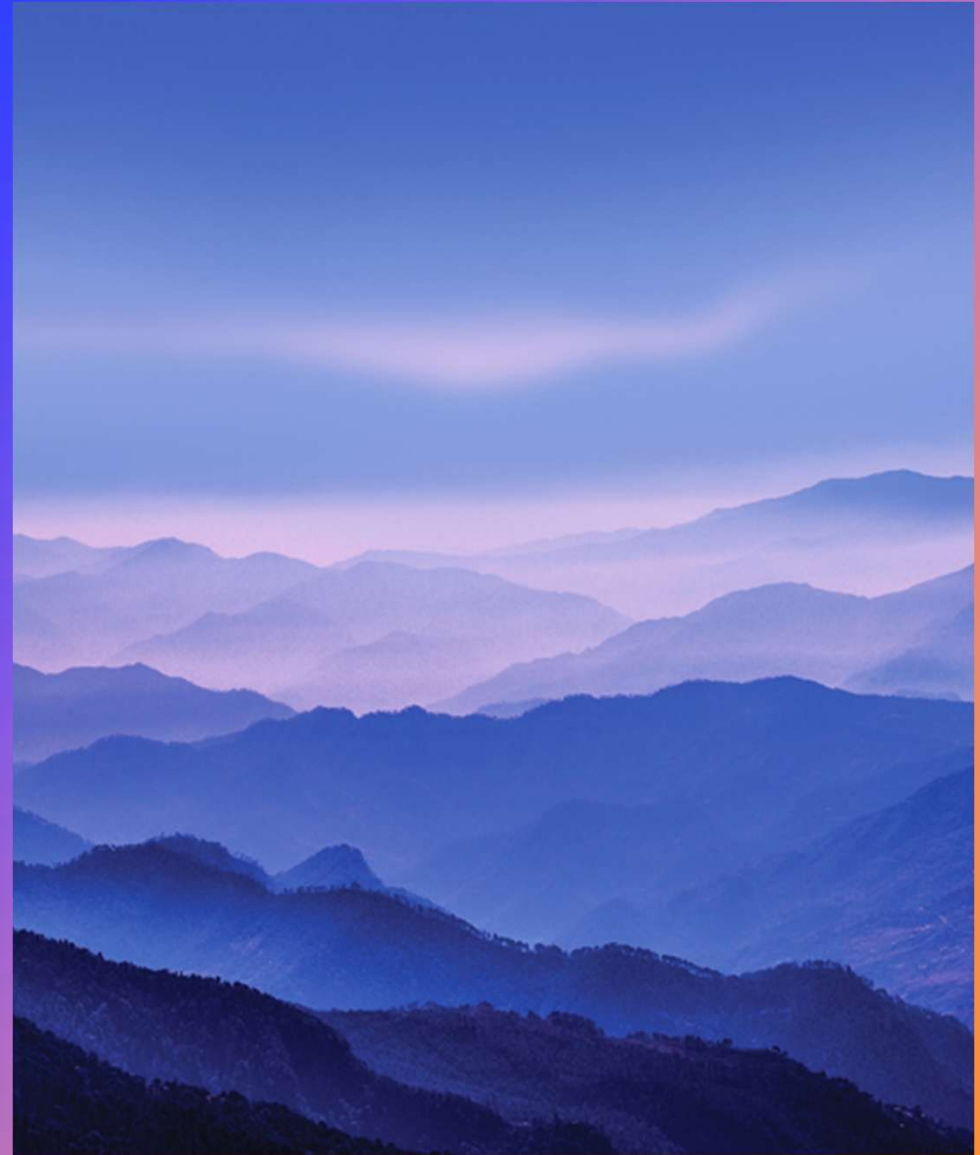

I’ll meet you there.”



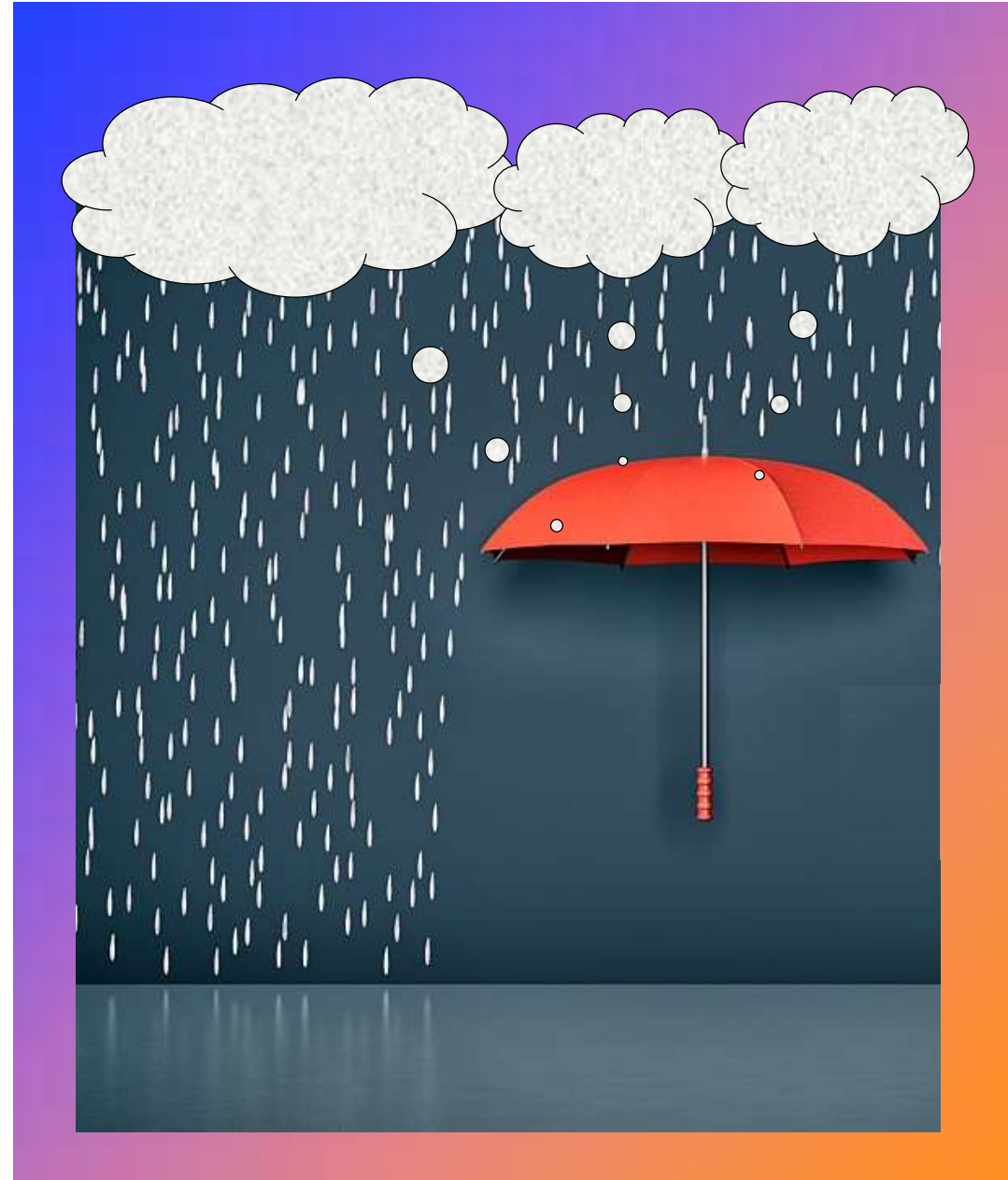

WHAT WENT WELL?

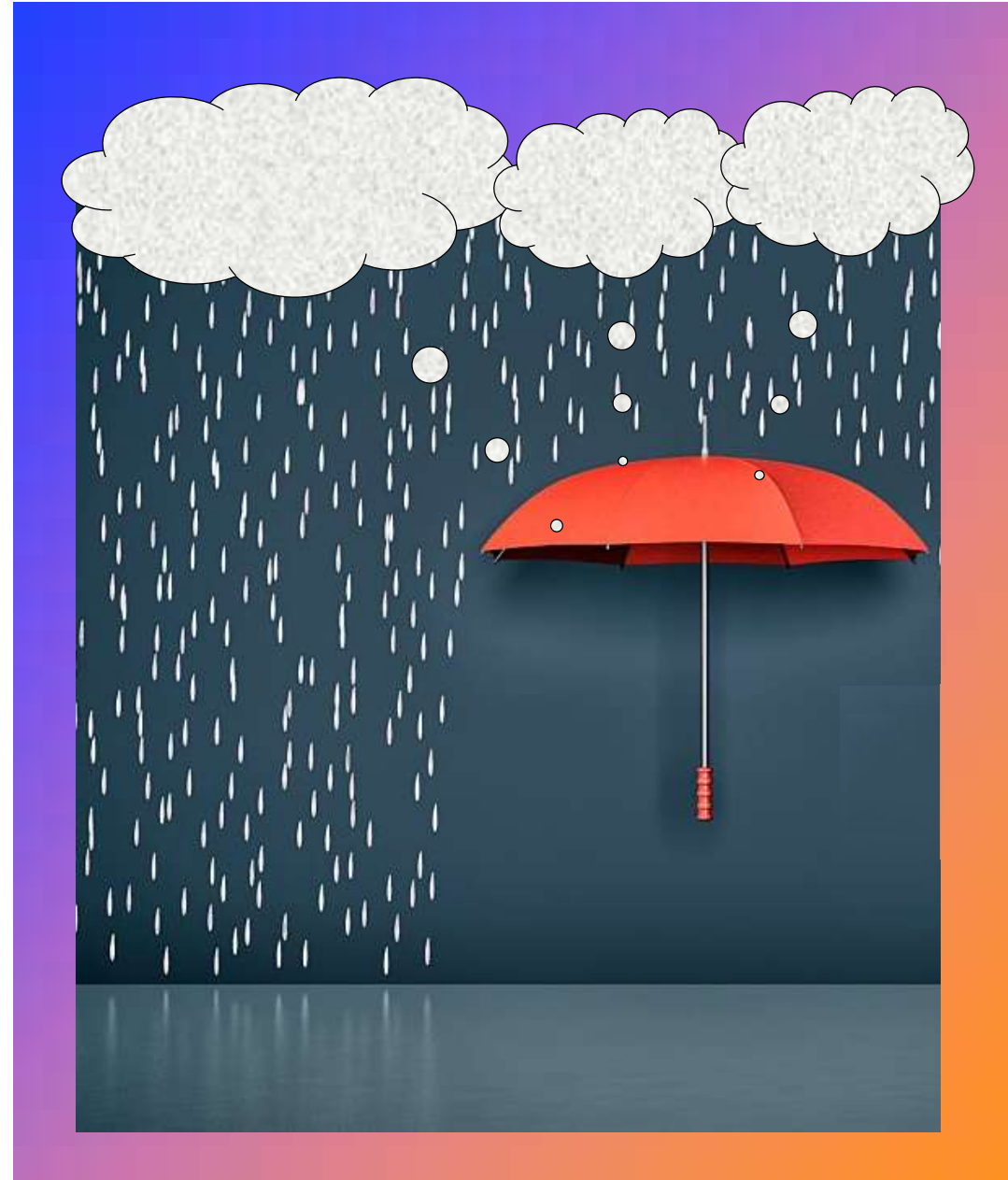
- It's been good to connect with other people and their faiths

WHAT COULD BE BETTER NEXT TIME?

- How to discuss a wider range of faiths:

 - Engage with other near U3A
 - Review Interfaith Subject Advice
 - Use of video e.g. Balanced View
- How to focus on our own systems of belief and experience of living in faith:
 - Focus on faith, maybe religion and not culture
 - Clarification in our ways of working (PK)



WHAT MIGHT WE DO DIFFERENTLY NEXT TIME?
